CARE MANAGEMENT

WHAT IS IT?

Care Management is the coordination of, and expedient access, to a range of appropriate medical and social services for the member and family. The goal is to promote and support the wellbeing of the member and their family unit.

FOR WHO?

Our services are for: children and youth from the ages of 3 to 20, who reside in Manhattan and/or the Bronx, who have active Medicaid, who have qualifying conditions, and medical and social needs.

WHAT IS THE COST?

Upper Manhattan Mental Health Center's Children's Care Management program is free! It is also a voluntary program, so members can disenroll at any time for any reason.



HOW CAN CARE MANAGEMENT HELP ME?

- Mediate communication between providers (doctors, social workers, etc.) and the member.
- Assist with medical and mental health referrals and appointments for the member.
- Provide support by attending medical and other types of appointments with the member.
- Schedule medical transportation appointments for the member.
- Link the member and family to variety of community referrals and resources.
- Help the member obtain and keep public benefits and entitlements.
- Solve medication, pharmacy, insurance, and social services issues.
- Aid during hospital discharge and follow-up appointments. Also during IEP development!
- Advocate on behalf of the member's interests.
- Act as a liaison between all of the member's providers.
- Help the member develop a person-centered care plan to improve their wellbeing.

WHAT ARE THE QUALIFYING CONDITIONS?

Eligibility depends on meeting medical qualifying conditions: ONE Single Qualifying condition or TWO Chronic Conditions. For both, we request documented medical proof of diagnosis.
